KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: THAT, We, Robert L. Thompson, A. C. Thompson, Richard Thompson, Belton Thompson, Charles Thompson (the said Charles Thompson being a single man), Agnes T. Abercrombie, Lou Mae T. Tumblin, Bessie T. McCuen, Dorothy T. Cooper and Virginia T. Davis, children of Lillian Sims Thompson, who died intestate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on or about the 9th day of October 1951, seized and possessed of the tract of land hereinafter described:

Our whole and entire undivided interest in and to -

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina on the Dunklin Bridge Road, containing forty-nine (49) acres, more or less, being all the balance and remainder of a tract of land containing fifty-three and sixty-eight one-hundredths (53.68) acres, more or less, owned by our mother, Lillian Sims Thompson, at the time of her death, she having conveyed two lots out of said 53.68 acres, more or less, one to Virginia Thompson containing 2.18 acres, more or less, deed of record in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 411, Page 311, and one to A. C. Thompson, containing one acre, more or less, deed of record in said Office in Deed Book 363, Page 371; the Heirs or children of the said Lillian Sims Thompson are conveying approximately one acre to A. C. Thompson, by deeds to be recorded, leaving a balance of the original tract being conveyed herewith of forty-nine (49) acres, more or less, said tract being bounded by lands of Abercrombie, Thompson, Davenport and others. Reference is made to the within named deeds and to paragraph two in a deed from Eula Sims McDougle and others to Lillian Sims Thompson, said deed of record in said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 231, Page 138, for a better and more complete description as to lines, corner, distances, etc.

The within named Grantors represent all the children of the said Lillian Sims Thompson, deceased, except Luther K. Thompson, his interest in the tract herein conveyed having been conveyed to the Grantees herein in a separate deed to be recorded.
