

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Greenville Properties, Inc.
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina
and having its principal place of business at
Greenville in the State of South Corolina
for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty-seven Hundred (\$3700,00) Dollars,
and the assumption of the Fortgage hereinbelow described
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto
H. L. Baumgardner and his heirs and assigns forever:
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the North side of East Stone Evenue and known and designated as Lot No. 17 on a plat made by J. M. Southern, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Deed Book VV at page 542 and according to said plat, described as follows:
BEGINNING at a stake 218 feet East of Elizabeth Street, corner of lot No. 16 and running thence N. 17 E., 206.6 feet to joint corners of Lots No. 16, 17, 32 and 33; thence with the line of Lot No. 32, S. 73 E., 54 1/2 feet to the joint corner of Lots No. 17, 18, 31 and 32; thence with the line of Lot No. 13, S. 17 No., 206 1/2 feet to a stake on Stone Avenue; thence with Stone Avenue, No. 73 No., 54 1/2 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of Lond conveyed to the grantor herein by Augusta Road Hardware Company, Inc., by Deed dated October 31, 1952, recorded in Deed Book 466 at page 63.
As a part of the consideration hereof, the grantee assumes and agrees to may the balance due on that certain Mortgage over said property held by the First Federal Savings and Loan Association, recorded in Mortgage Book 525 at page 270.
