TITLE TO CEMETERY LOT

Know all men by these presents, That Mrs. J.A. Gosnell for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty \$350.00 Dollars, to her in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents, by Hazel R. Ponder, the receipt whereof is here- by acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, Do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Hazel R. Ponder two thirds (2/3) of/or 4 grave spaces of the six grave Lot No. 50, Section L, of Springwood Cemetery, having the following dimensions, to-wit:

North-16', East-11', South-8', West-7' 3", South-8',

West-3' 9" and more particularly described as follows:

The three grave spaces on the Eastern half, and the one grave

space on the Northwest corner of Lot No. 50, Sec. L, of said

cemetary, for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of the City of Greenville, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and cemetery trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

Together with all and singular, the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances of said premises belonging, or in anywise incident appertaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Hazel R. Ponder, her heirs and assigns forever; subject however, to the limitations and conditions herein before imposed.

And she does hereby bind herself, her heirs and assigns to warrant, and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Hazel R. Ponder, her heirs and assigns, against herself and her heirs, and against every other person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
