all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in Austin Township, Greenville County and State aforesaid, more fully described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a stone 3X s.w. on the road south east corner of church lot, thence n. 53 3/4 E. 1.25 chain to iron pin 3X n.w., thence by a new line N. 36 W. 4.00 chain to stone 3X n.w., thence south 53 3/4 W. 1.25 to stone 3X S.W., thence S. 36 E. 4.00 to the beginning corner and containing one half of one acre, said land being a part of the two acres conveyed to the Deacons of New Pilgrim Baptist Church by deed of Alexander Abercrombie dated November 1895, and recorded in office of R.M.C. for said County in Book B.R.B. page 541 and lying by lands of the Estate of Alexander Abercrombie, D.D.
