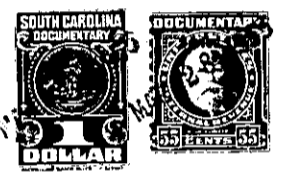


Know All Men by These Presents:

Finchum, OLLIE FARNSWORTH to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Will and Emma B. Finchum, their Heirs and Assigns for ever;

A Lot or parcel of Ground, in Graceland Cemetery, Greenville County, South Carolina. Designated as lot No. 530 Section No. Five (5) Containing 200 Square feet, more or less; The same being Described and designated as above, in accordance with map on file in the Office of said Cemetery. It is distinctly understood that said lot is to be used exclusively for the burial of human bodies of the white race, and sold and conveyed subject to all rules and regulations printed on Original Deed, and any additions or amendments for the government of the Cemetery which may hereafter be adopted.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions and limitations, of the Original Deed, made to this Grantor, by the Greenville Cemetery Association, a Corporation, same as Recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Vol.80 Page 201 of August 3rd, 1921.



TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever. And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
