This Power of Attorney shall be revoked by death or revocation by me in writing.

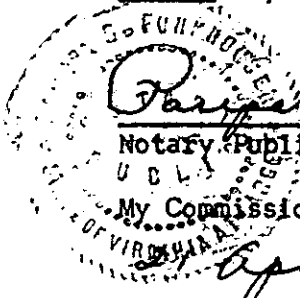
