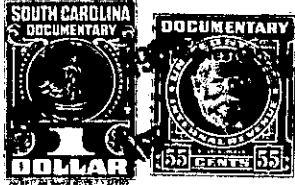

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Katie D. Tollison,.....
her heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grave Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, lying and being situated West of Highway No. 29
between Piedmont and Pelzer 204 feet from Highway #29, North Beth School
District, State and County aforesaid, having the following courses and
distances to wit:-

Beginning at stake N-85-W 204 feet from West side of Concrete paving
Highway Number 29, thence S-0-1/4- W 108 feet to a stone corner of
Charlie Massey line, thence along line of Charley Massey S-88-W 175
feet to corner of property now or formerly owned by Edgar Boyce, thence
along line of Edgar Boyce N-6-3/4 W 122 feet to stake corner of new
26 foot wide street, thence along un-named street S-88-W 175 feet to
point of beginning."
