


reversion, the following described property, to-wit: "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and commencing at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Sunrise Street, on the line of J. J. Whitt, in the town of Mauldin and running thence along Sunrise Street on which it fronts S.60-15 W for 80 feet to a point; thence N. 24-45 West for 125 feet to a point; thence N. 60-15 E. for 80 feet to a point; thence S. 24-45 East for 125 feet to the point of beginning. This is a portion of the property shown on a plat of survey of Jim Willis Whitt, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, 1953; said lot is bounded on the Southeast by Sunrise Street, on the Southwest and Northwest by lands of J. Willis Whitt, and on the Northeast by lands of J. J. Whitt and Clade Herbert.
