That I, O. O. FREEMAN

in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred and No/100 - - - - - DOLLARS, (\$2200.00)

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WILLIAM B. DUCKER, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate on the East side of Brockman Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 6 on plat of property of O. O. Freeman, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, October, 1954, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "X", at page 78, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Brockman Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 5 and 6 and running thence along the line of lot 5, S. 78-53 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-11 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of lot 7, N. 78-53 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Brockman Avenue; thence with the East side of Brockman Avenue N. 10-11 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
