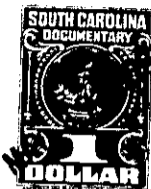
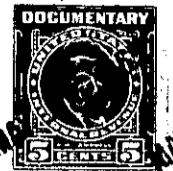

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said TIMBER-LANDS, INC., its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown on a plat made by Howard Wiswall, C. E., dated 1918 through 1921, which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "Y", at pages 114 through 118, and said tracts being more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1. All those certain tracts or parcels of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing in the aggregate 357 acres, mor or less, situate, lying and being on the waters of Gap Creek, branch waters of Middle Saluda River, bounded on the South by lands now or formerly of Potts, on the West, North and East by lands now or formerly of Cleveland, et al, as fully described on the plat mentioned above as "No. C-IX, No. C-X, M.
