

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CHARLIE PACK and VIOLA W. PACK, their heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Greenville Township, being known and designated as LOT NO. 93 of a Subdivision known as City View Annex according to a plat thereof prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, April 1927 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "G", at pages 152 and 155 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Agnew Road at the joint front corner of Lots 92 and 93 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, North 53-40 East 414 feet to a branch; thence following said branch as the line, in a Southeasterly direction 80 feet, more or less, to the joint rear corner of Lots 93 and 94; thence along the joint line of said lots, South 53-40 West 406 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Agnew Road; thence along the Northeast side of said road, in a Northwesterly direction 80 feet to the beginning corner. This being the same property conveyed to the Grantor herein by deed of Winfred J. Hickum dated Feb. 1, 1952 and recorded in Deed Book 450, at page 371, RMC Office for Greenville County.

This property is shown on the Township Block Book at Sheet 133, Block 4, Lot 25.
