Barton land, and running thence along the Barton line, N. 6.00 E. 600 feet to a stake; thence N. 40.15 W. 99 feet to a stake; thence N. 26.30 E. 297 feet to a stake; thence N. 29.30 E. 174 feet to a stake; thence N. 76.00 E. 419 feet to a stake; thence N. 29.25 W. 450 feet to a stake; thence S. 26.00 W. 200 feet to a stake; thence S. 43.00 W. 156 feet to a stake; thence S. 50.45 W. 198 feet to a stake; thence S. 32.30 W. 81 feet to a stake; thence S. 24.30 W. 166 feet to a stake; thence S. 50.00 W. 112 feet to a stake; thence S. 31.30 W. 67 feet to a stake; thence S. 23.30 E. 279 feet to a stake; thence N. 86.00 W. 205 feet to a stake; thence S. 5.00 W. 524 feet to a stake; thence S. 17.30 W. 297 feet to a stake on South Tyger River; thence down said river as the line to the beginning corner.

It is understood and agreed that the described property, along with other parcels on South Tyger River, is to be used by the Commission of Public Works for a water shed and reservoir for the City of Greer. The seller herein, as long as he owns the adjoining tract from which the above described tract is conveyed, or the subsequent owners of the same, shall have the following rights and privileges, but subject to the following restrictions:

1. To pasture to the water line, or to cultivate crops to the high water mark in flood season; to withdraw water for irrigation purposes when the same is available, subject to State laws and regulations.
