the Easterly side of Welcome Street, near the City of Greenville, being

recorded in the R.R.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat
Book "A", page 179 and having according to said plat the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

beginning at an iron pin on the Easterly side of Welcome Street
