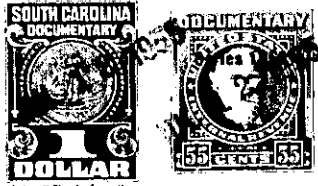

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Robert Blackston  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of (\$500.00) Five Hundred  
and No/100 Dollars  
to me, Robert Blackston, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by James T. Morton  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James T. Morton  
his heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, known as lot number 20 of the B. W.  
Burdette subdivision located at Grove Station, S. C. and  
having the following metes and bounds to wit:-

"Beginning at iron pin corner of lots Nos. 19 and 20, thence  
along line of lot No. 19 - 140 feet and 5 inches to iron pin;  
thence along Clarks line 151 feet to corner of lots nos. 20  
and 21; thence along line of lot no. 21 - 154 feet corner center  
of dirt road, thence along dirt road 150 feet to point of origin."

This being a piece, parcel or proportion of land conveyed to  
I. N. Moody by deed by B. W. Burdette.
