WHEREAS, I, William David Moore, am now of full legal age, sound mind and body, and

WHEREAS, I am now a member of the United States Armed Forces serving with the United States Army and am now about to embark upon a tour of foreign duty, and

WHEREAS, I desire that my affairs be carried on in my behalf in my absence, and that my sister, Martha E. Moore, is fully competent to act in my behalf.

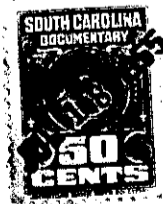
NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, William David Moore, of Route # 8, Greenville, S. C. do hereby appoint my sister, Martha E. Moore of the same address, as my Attorney for me and in my name and on my behalf to do and execute all and any act, deed or thing as I might or could do if personally present.

Such as to execute, acknowledge, and cause to be recorded any and all instruments which it may be necessary or desirable for me to execute including contracts of sale conveying the title to any property owned by me or in which I have any interest, present or contingent, and to give full warranty deeds in my behalf. It is my intention to give this authority to my Attorney so as to include my real, personal, or mixed property.

This power is extended so that she may sell any or all of my property or trade same at any time and on such terms and for such amounts as she may deem best to whomever she may choose.

In addition, she is to have such powers as are necessary to execute any and all instruments necessary to carry out or perform any of the foregoing powers and to do any other acts requisite to the carrying out of such powers.
