all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as No. 4 property
of Charles M. Parker, as per Plat thereof recorded in the R. C. Office
for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book T at page 408, and having
according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:
