in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Leslie and Shaw, Inc., its successors and assigns forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lots 65, 66 and 67 of a subdivision known as Paris-Piney Park as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at pages 19 and 20 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwest corner of the intersection of Orlando Avenue and Lakeland, and running thence along the west side of Lakeland Avenue, N. 28-53 E. 150.5 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 55-30 W. 160.9 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 64; thence along the line of that lot, S. 34-30 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Orlando Avenue; thence along the north side of said Orlando Avenue, S.55-30 E. 175.3 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lots were conveyed to me as follows: Lots Nos. 66 and 67 were conveyed to me by L. F. Simpson, Jr. by deed dated August 9, 1940 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 225, page 20.

The above lots are shown on the Township Tax Map at Sheet 173, Block 2, Lots 20, 21 and 22, and the grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1955, said taxes having been pro-rated as of this date.
