KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, W. H. Patterson, husband, and Lucile Patterson, Wife, for value received, enter into the following marital agreement, to wit: <u>SETTLEMENT</u> - as follows:

- 1. For and in consideration of the benefits coming to him in paragraph numbered 2 hereof, the said W. H. Patterson does hereby give and transfer to the said Lucile Patterson, her personal representatives and assigns forever:
 - (a) His 1950 chevrolet automobile, bearing S. C. License No. D-121876 for 1954 1955;
 - (b) The business known as the W. H. Patterson Company, engaged in the retail credit sale of dry goods, and consisting of the stock of goods on hand and accounts receiveable; Provided, that the business name is bhanged, and not continued under the name of W. H. Patterson Company.

The said W. H.  - (a) Relieve the said W. H. Patterson of all duty and obligation whatsoever to support or provide for her arising because of their marital relationship, and does hereby waive and relinquish all rights arising by reason of her being his wife;
 - (b) Does hereby waive, relinquish and renounce all right to and of dower in and to the property of the said W. H. Patterson, both real and personal, now owned and/or hereafter acquired, and likewise, any and all rights in lieu or substitution of dower. And the said Lucile Patterson agrees to formally renounce dower to any and all property, at any and all times, if requested so to do by the said W. H. Patterson.

The said Lucile Patterson also agrees to change the name of the aforesaid dry goods business, and to not operate it under the name of W. H. Patterson Company, or any other name that might be confused therewith, and to create no obligations, in connection with said business or otherwise, for the payment or performance of which the said W. H. Patterson might in any way be held responsible or liable therefor.
