That We, Arbutus C. Garrison and Gladys C. Burroughs,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ninety-Five and No/100 (95.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. S. Flanagan, his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the Northeast rear portion of Lot No. 30, in Section B of the Willis property as shown on a plat made by J. Riddle, Surveyor, and recorded in the R. L. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "J", Pages 150 and 151 and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern line of said Lot No. 30, 200 feet in an Easterly direction from Willis Avenue and running thence 19 feet, more or less, to a pin at the Northeast rear corner of said Lot No. 30; thence with line of lot of William Foster and the rear line of Lot No. 30, 100 feet to an Iron pin to corner of lot owned by J. A. Jones; thence in a westerly direction with the Northern line of his lot 170 feet, more or less, to a stake on corner of Mack Simpson lot, which is 200 feet in an Easterly direction from the Eastern side of Willis Avenue; thence in a Northernly direction in line parallel with Willis Avenue 75 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

Beatrice C. Jones, Arbutus C. Garrison and Gladys Burroughs were devisees this lot as will appear of record in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C., in Apartment 545, File 19.

The grantor herein grants unto the grantee the right and privilege to the use and enjoyment of this lot an easement for the purpose of a pipe line to be used for the purpose of carrying water from Willis Avenue to the above described lot running across Lot No. 30 on the East side of Willis Avenue. This easement is appurtenant and shall run with the land.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
