

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on the corner of Line Street and Bennett Street in the City of Greer, designated as Lot No. 6 on the Cureton Survey of the M.L. Marchant Property, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the said Line Street and Bennett Street, and running thence along said Line Street, N. $1\frac{1}{2}$ E. 68 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of Lot No. 7, 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. $1\frac{1}{2}$ W. 65 feet to Bennett Street; thence along said Bennett Street, S. $88\frac{1}{2}$ E. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

Also, all that other certain parcel or lot of land adjoining that above described, being Lot No. 7 on the Cureton Survey of the M.L. Marchant Property, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Line Street, corner of Lot No. 6, and running thence along line Street in a northward direction, 68 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 8; thence along the line of Lot No. 8 in a westward direction 150 feet; thence 68 feet in a southern direction to corner of Lot No. 6; thence along the line of Lot No. 6, 150 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to G.W. Painter by deed of L.M. Smith, recorded in Deed Book 87, page 326, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

The said G.W. Painter died intestate in 1927, leaving as his only heirs at law and distributees his wife, Georgia B. Painter, and his children, Woodrow B. Painter, U. Sherman Painter, G. Dewey Painter and Lois Painter Jackson. The said Georgia B. Painter died in February, 1954, leaving her last will and testament whereby she devised her interest in the property described to her children named herein.
