Fountain R. Cox, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the westerly side of Bent Twig Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 5 on the plat of Biltmore as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "Y", page 147, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Bent Twig Drive at a point 680.5 feet north of the northwesterly corner of the intersection of Bent Twig Drive and Two Notch Road, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6, and running thence along the westerly side of Bent Twig Drive N 14-46 E 75 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence along the joint line of said Lots N 75-14 W 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S 14-46 W 75 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence along the joint line of said Lots S 75-14 E 150 feet to the point of beginning.
