KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that We, W. H. CORBETT and WADDELL A. CORBETT, Partners, Trading as CORBETT BROTHERS, in consideration of the sum of TEN AND NO/100 (\$10.00) DOLLARS and other valuable considerations, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the MOUNTAIN LAND IMPROVEMENT COMPANY, INC., (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said MOUNTAIN LAND IMPROVEMENT COMPANY, INC., its Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All of the lands and interests in lands, with buildings and improvements thereon, owned by the Grantors in Greenville County, S. C., specifically including, but not limiting this conveyance thereto, the following described properties:

(1) That tract of land in Glassy Mountain Township on both sides of Jamison's Mill Creek and Bellew's Mill Creek, waters of South Pacolet River, containing 72 acres, more or less, and being described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING on a locust near a large rock and running thence S. 75 W. 17.50 chains to a stake X on Southwest face of Big Rock in southeast slope of Hogback Mountain; thence S. 31 1/2 W. (this line running along impassable cliffs of rock) 31.00 chains to a hickory; thence N. 60 E. 25.00 chains to a poplar stump on line of fence; thence N. 5 W. 14.00 ch. to a chestnut oak stump; thence N. 24 E. 21.00 chains to the beginning corner, containing seventy-two (72) acres, more or less.

(2) All that tract of land in Glassy Mountain Township on Jamison's Mill Creek of South Pacolet River, containing 128 acres, more or less, and being described by metes and bounds as follows:
