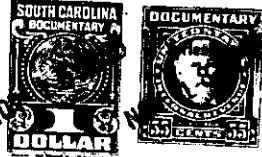

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Sue Payne Bishop, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and No/100 in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s)

William T. Bishop, his Heirs and Assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, lying on the south side of the Buncombe Road (now State Highway No. 415), being a "L" in shape, bounded on the north by lot of William T. Bishop and the said highway No. 415, on the east and south by other lands of myself and on the west by the lot of William T. Bishop and lands formerly of the Brookshire Estate, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin on the south edge of the said highway, the northeast corner of the William T. Bishop lot, and runs thence with the east line of this lot, S. 23-15 W. 208.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the south line of the said lot, N. 58-45 W. 208.5 feet to a stake on the former Brookshire land; thence with the line of this, the Brookshire line, S. 23-15 W. 104.5 feet to an iron pin on the said line; thence a new line S. 58-45 E. 269.5 feet to an iron pin; thence another new line, N. 31-15 E. 310 feet to an iron pin on the south margin of the said highway; thence with the south margin of the said highway, N. 58-45 W. 104.5 feet to the beginning corner, containing Onw and ##### EightOne-hundredths (1.08) acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining
