"All that certain lot or parcel of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, bounded by lands of Barton Foster and Carruth, BEGINNING on a sourwood and running S. 88 E. 8.25 chains to a Sweet Gum; thence S. $86\frac{1}{4}$ E. 22 chains to a chestnut oak; thence N. 1 E. 50.40 chains to a stone; thence S. $76\frac{1}{4}$ W. 26.75 chains to a dead chestnut; thence N. $58\frac{1}{2}$ W. 34.40 chains to a Red Oak; thence S. 12 W. 11.75 chains to a Post Oak; thence S. $41\frac{1}{2}$ W. 16.55 chains to a stone; thence S. $88\frac{1}{2}$ W. 23 chains to a Spanish Oak down; thence S. $41\text{-}3/4$ E. 7.50 chains to a stone; thence S. $64\frac{1}{2}$ E. 61 chains to the beginning corner, containing Two Hundred and Ninety Two (292) acres, more or less.

It is the purpose of this deed to convey to the Grantee herein all the land situated in the County of Greenville and involved in the above entitled action, the said land having been sold in two separate parcels and each separate parcel having been bid in by the Grantee herein.

Further, the purpose of this present deed is to correct a deed concerning this same property of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 342, at Page 234, which deed inadvertently left out call No. 8 in this present deed.

No revenue stamps are necessary on this deed as it is only for the purpose of correcting a former deed made by the Master concerning this same property.
