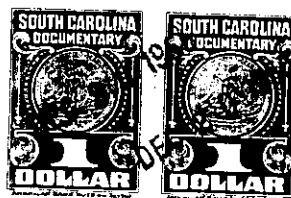

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, being known and designated as LOT NO. 122 on Churchill Avenue in Subdivision known as Piedmont Estates and being shown on plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "M", at page 123, RMC Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Churchill Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots 121 and 122 and running thence along the joint line of said lots South 24-0 West 175 feet to an iron pin; running thence South 66-0 East 60 feet to an iron pin; running thence North 24-0 East 175 feet to an iron pin on Churchill Avenue; running thence along Churchill Avenue, North 66-0 West 60 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
