in full consideration for the additional line rights covering the second pipe line to be laid across lands now owned by the undersigned, and referred to hereinbelow, in pursuance of and in accordance with the same terms and conditions of an instrument granting a pipe line easement and right of way, dated, July 16, 1941, August 19, 1941 and July 26,

July 26, 1941, executed by I. D. Sullivan, Jr. Exec. I. E. Sullivan Est.; T. J. Sullivan; Missouri Sullivan; Nannie Sullivan; W. P. Sullivan; Annie Thomason; Maude Thomason; Hugh Sullivan; and P. D. Sullivan to PLANTATION PIPE LINE COMPANY, recorded in the public records of

Greenville County/Parish, State of South Carolina in Book or Volume 238;

238; 238, Page or Folio 151; 155; and 150, covering the same lands described in said instrument, situate in said County and State; or a portion thereof, said portion being described as follows, to-wit:

The undersigned being Gussie Thomason, Clyde Sullivan, and Collie Sullivan, Heirs at Law of I. D. Sullivan, Dec. hereby adopt, ratify and confirm all the terms and requirements of the above cited easements with the same force and effect as if they had been one of the signers thereof. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto Plantation Pipe Line Company so long as a pipe line is maintained thereon.

The undersigned covenants and warrants that he is now the lawful owner of the aforesaid lands, and that he is legally entitled to receive this payment. The undersigned acknowledges notice, and agrees to notify his successor in title, if any, of the intention of PLANTATION PIPE LINE COMPANY to lay and construct a second pipe line across the said lands and accepts the above payment in full discharge of said Company's obligation, created by said instrument, for the second pipe line rights, regardless of the time such pipe line shall hereafter be laid. Said Company agrees to pay any damage to crops, fences, and timber as provided in said instrument.

The undersigned further represents that the said property owned by him is subject to no tenancy, lease, mortgage, judgment, or other encumbrance or occupancy, except as follows:
