all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina lying on the north side of McAlhaney Road  
and bounded by lands of Grantor on the north and west, and by Frank  
Gilreath on the east, and by Ruth Gilreath on the south and containing  
One Acre, more or less, having the following metes and bounds:

beginning at a point in center of McAlhaney Road, the corner  
of Ruth and Frank Gilreath lands, and running thence N. 7-30 E. 311.1  
feet to iron pin; thence with a new line N. 81-00 W. 132 feet to iron  
pin; thence S. 9-00 W. 311.1 feet over iron pipe to point in center of
