the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. D. Ridgeway,

"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in Dunklin Township, near Columbia Church, in the County of Greenville, in the state aforesaid, and having the following lines, metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone 3X, and running thence S. 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 15 chains and 75 links to a stone 3X, thence N. 79 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5.75 to a stone, thence N. 7 E. 16.30 to W. O., thence to a stone 3X at branch or creek, thence up said branch to a stake 3X, thence N. 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 10.85 to a stake 3X, thence N. 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.25 to a stake at the creek, thence up said creek to a stone 3X, thence S. 24 W. 55.15 to the beginning, and said to include ninety one (91) acres, more or less, bounded by lands now or formerly belonging to A.
