That We, William Golden, John R. Golden, ^{LOVETT} Dorothy G. Davis, Jean E. Lovett and Nellie Davis Glenn, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifty and No/100 -- -- (\$50.00) ----- DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said S. M. Forrester, his Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All our right, title and interest in and to:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Austin Township, near the Town of Mauldin, and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin (Leo Champion's corner), and running thence N. 74-35 E. 487.5 feet to pin; thence S. 30 E. 103.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 36-30 E. 83 feet to pin; thence S. 74-35 W. 515.5 feet to pin; thence N. 24-30 W. 180 feet to the beginning corner, containing two acres, more or less.

Being the same property conveyed to J. W. Golden by Deed dated September 6, 1940, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 226, at page 88. J. W. Golden died intestate and the purpose of this Deed is to convey the interests which we inherited from him.

The ^{first four} Grantors hereinabove named are all of the children of Luther Golden, deceased, with the exception of Mary Ann Golden and Kenneth Golden, both of whom are under the age of 21 years. Luther Golden died intestate several years ago and was a brother of J. W. Golden, deceased. The last named Grantor, Nellie Davis Glenn, was the only child of Alpha Golden Davis, who died intestate, she being a sister of J. W. Golden.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
