Setzer and His Heirs and Assigns forever,

ALL that tract of land lying and being situated in State and County Aforesaid containing fifty-eight (58) acres, more or less, bounded on the South by Land formerly owned by Alice Brooks; on the West by Reed River; on the North by tract No. 5 and on the East by tract No. 5 of the lands of the late John M.
