Pace (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bab L. Pace his heirs and assigns, all that tract of land lying in the County of Greenville and the State of South Carolina and bounded as follows.—Beginning at a Stake in the Branch, N. 1¹/₂ E. 30° 40' 00" from a large White Oak, thence N. 84° W. 24° 00' 00" Poles to a Stake in the branch, thence S. 34° W. 16° 00' 00" Poles to a Dogwood, thence N. 63° E. 40° 00' 00" Poles to a small white Oak, thence N. 10° W. 10° 00' 00" Poles to a Stake in the lane, thence S. 77° E. 53° 00' 00" Poles to a dead Chestnut, thence S. 42° W. 17° 00' 00" Poles to a large dead Chestnut, thence S. 18° E. 30° 00' 00" Poles to a small black gum, at the branch, thence down the branch to the beginning, containing 33 acres, more or less. This tract includes the lands of Sam Survey and Bab Pace;
