CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, EDWARD E. MASON of 119 Beth Drive, Greenville, South Carolina
J. M. TRUESDALE of 413 Wilton Street, Greenville, South Carolina
J. W. JAMES of 2 Von Hollen Drive, Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 29th day of February, 1956, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is GREENVILLE DRIVING RANGE, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is New Buncombe Road, Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to operate a general recreation center, consisting, among other things, of golf courses of every type, swimming pool, fishing lake, club, concession stands and every other thing in connection therewith.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Ten Thousand Five Hundred (\$10,500.00) Dollars payable in cash on demand

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Three (3) of the par value of Three Thousand Five Hundred (\$3,500.00) ----- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 6th day of February, 1956, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: J. M. Truesdale, Edward E. Mason and J. W. James

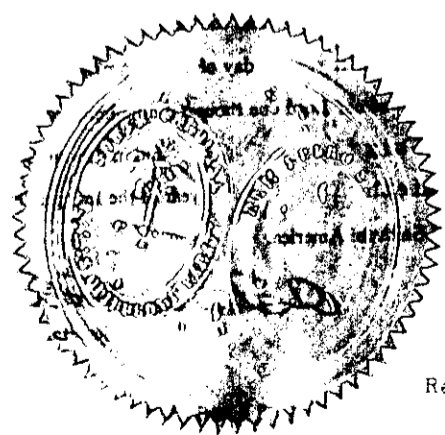
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, J. M. Truesdale ;
as Vice-President, Edward E. Mason ; as Secretary, J. W. James ;
as Treasurer, J. W. James

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greer Citizen

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the afore-said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
