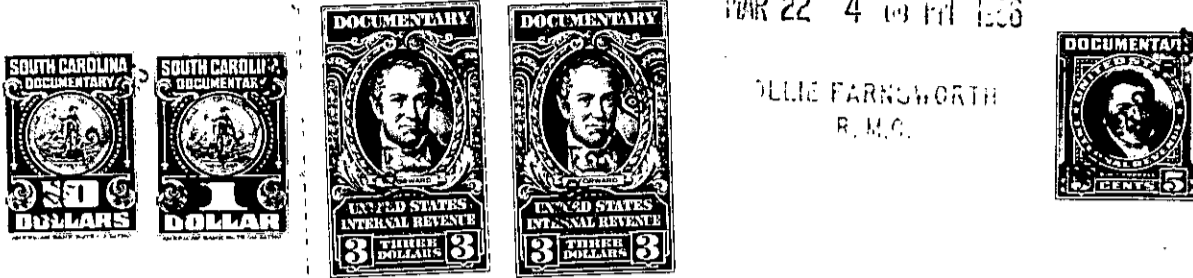

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these pres-
ents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH
CAROLINA, its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all the buildings
and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Saluda Township,
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and
designated as Tract Twenty-four (24) in Section "I", of Carolina
Lake Colony Development as shown on Plat Number Four (4), made by
J. Mac Richardson and Howard B. Miller, registered land surveyors,
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book
"W", at page 184 and page 185.

THIS is the same property conveyed to the Grantors herein by deed of
Carolina Lake Colony, Inc., dated July 29, 1952, and recorded in the
