EARLE M. LINEBERGER and E. M. PAUL, Jr., their heirs and assigns forever.

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land on the Eastern side of South Carolina Highway No. 291, just outside the Corporate Limits of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as LOT NO. 3 according to a Survey of the property of J. H. Sitton made by Piedmont Engineering Service, April 13, 1955, recorded in Plat Book II, at page 127, RMC Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds according to said Survey:

BEGINNING at a point on the Eastern side of South Carolina Highway No. 291 at the joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3 and running thence along said Highway, South 1-45 West 50 feet to a point; thence South 88-15 East 183.7 feet to a point; thence North 0-43 East 50.02 feet along a Service Alley; running thence North 88-15 West 182.01 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

With the right of ingress and egress to said Service Alley shown on said Plat.
