Provided also, that in case said building and premises, or any part thereof, shall at any time be destroyed or damaged by fire or other unavoidable casualty, so that the same shall be unfit for occupation or use, then the rent hereby reserved, or a fair and just proporation thereof, according to the nature and extent of the damage sustained, shall be suspended and cease to be payable until said premises shall be rebuilt or made fit for occupation and use by the said lessor, or these presents shall thereby be determined and ended, at the election of the said lessor.
