

7. To eject or remove tenants or other persons from, and recover possession of, all such properties, by all lawful means; to demolish, repair, rebuild, alter, improve, insure, preserve, store, transport, take possession of, and otherwise manage and control, any or all properties in which I now or hereafter acquire any right, title or interest.

8. To buy, sell, exchange, lease, or rent, register, reregister, mortgage, encumber, borrow money upon, take out licenses in respect of, insure, collect insurance upon, and otherwise deal with any automobile or automobiles;

9. To purchase, sell, exchange, mortgage, pledge, lease or rent, and in any and every manner deal in with any and all other personal property of every kind whatsoever, tangible and intangible, which I may own or in which I now have or hereafter may acquire, any right, title or interest;

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and to perform all and every act, deed, matter and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present, and the above specially enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the full, complete, and general power herein granted and not in limitation or definition thereof; and hereby ratifying all that my said attorney MRS. K. VERNER shall do or cause to be done in these presents.
