to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located near the North Carolina State Line, on the East side of Laurel Drive at Camp Onawa, and having the following description:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Laurel Drive, at joint corner of the Kay lot, and running thence with the West edge of the said Drive, S. 22-30 E., 94 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 67-16 E., 201.5 feet (Ground measurement 220.5 feet) to a stake on the East side of the new road; thence with the East edge of said new road, N. 8-30 W., 78 feet, more or less, to the Holt corner; thence with the Holt line, S. 54-45 W., 122 feet (Ground measurement 140.0 feet) to a stake joint corner of Kay and Holt lots; thence with the Northern line of the Kay lot, S. 80-55 W., 100 feet to the beginning corner.

Grantors herein also convey all right and interest in and to, or the use of the spring located on lands of Mrs. Cora Ward Hawkins.

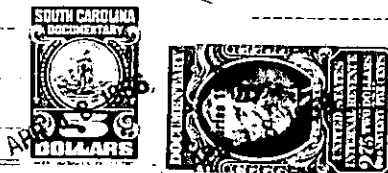
