to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Roger F. Roberts, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Southwesterly side of Cool Brook Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 57 on the plat of Belmont Heights as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book GG, pages 54 and 55, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Cool Brook Drive at a point 380 feet southeast of the southerly corner of the intersection of Cool Brook Drive and Melvin Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 56 and 57, and running thence along the southwesterly side of Cool Brook Drive S 24-34 E 70 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 57 and 58; thence along the joint line of said Lots S 64-26 W 163 feet to the center of a branch; thence with the branch as the line, a traverse line being N 54-12 W 45.1 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the center of the branch as the line, a traverse line being N 18-34 E 42.2 feet to an iron pin, joining rear corner of Lots Nos. 56 and 57; thence with the joint line of said lots N 64-26 E 155 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
