ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake in the Greenville-Hendersonville Highway and running thence N. 34 W. 24 poles to a Spanish Oak; thence N. 65 E. 7 poles to a Water Oak; thence 15 E. 25 poles to a stake in said road; thence with the said road N. 53 E. 4 poles to the beginning corner, including right, title and interest in the spring granted in the deed of Cora and Hawkins, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 105, page 395.
