BEGINNING at a point in center of paved county road where branch flows under said road, thence in a southerly direction with branch as the eastern boundary of said tract (offset line commences in center of said paved county road 69.2 feet from nail and bottle top over double culvert, said offset point being west of branch, thence S. 4-58 W. 383.1 foot to point, thence S. 71-28 W. 90.3 feet to point, thence S. 36-59 E. 170 foot to point, thence S. C-26 W. 220 feet to IP now), thence N. 68-44 E. 437.3 foot to IP now 50 feet from railroad tract, thence N. S-51 E. 1047 foot along the right-of-way of C. & G. R.
