of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Julia Walker, her heirs and assigns forever, all that piece,
parcel, or tract of land lying, being and situated, in the County and State
aforesaid and in Paris Mountain Township and containing seventeen (17)
acres, more or less, and has the following marks, bearings, and distances
to-wit;

BEGINNING at a red oak 3 X 0 M; on Cedar Lane Road; thence S. 29 1/4 W.
19.50 to a pine 3 X 0. M. (now a stone); thence S. 62 E. 7.00 to a stone
3 X N M, thence N. 82, E. 10.10 to an iron pin in center of bridge
3 X N M; Thence 19.95 up the Cedar Lane Road to the beginning corner, this
tract is known as tract No. 1, of the estate of Thomas Thompson, as shown
by plat made by John M. Cureton, D. S. on Nov. 14, 1905 and is bounded
by tracts Nos. 2 and 4 and by Hawkins, Edwards, and the Cedar Lane Road.
