BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Lake Fairfield Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 80 and 81, Section I, Lake Forest Subdivision, which iron pin is 305 feet from the intersection of Lake Fairfield Drive and Shannon Drive, and running thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 80 and 81 N. 24-47 W. 168.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 55 and 80, Section I, Lake Forest Subdivision, S. 63-28 W. 25.6 feet to an iron pin; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 56 and 80 S. 59-24 W. 98 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 79 and 80, Section I, Lake Forest Subdivision; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots S. 29-46 E. 169.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Lake Fairfield Drive; thence along the Northern side of Lake Fairfield Drive N. 61-43 E. 110 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
