Storage charges to the State of South Carolina as per list. 2. Insurance premiums, salary of manager, wages of laborers, and all charges connected with storing and handling cotton in said warehouse. (II.) J. Roy Jones, as Commissioner, agrees to lease the said warehouse of the aforesaid Blake P. Garrett and David H. Garrett, Owner, and Charles T. Bell, Leassee and to pay the sum of One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollar as rent therefor for a period as long as the same is operated as a State Warehouse.
