same for the construction, maintenance, operation and repair of said portion of said industrial track: PROVIDED, however, and this conveyance is made upon the condition, that in the event that the Southern Railway Company shall, at any time hereafter, abandon said industrial track, and in evidence thereof shall discontinue the operation of the same, and take up and remove the rails, materials and fixtures therein, then and in such event, the easement or right of way hereby conveyed and all rights incident or appurtenant thereto shall revert to the Grantor, its successors and assigns.
