to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Leslie & Shaw, Inc.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the Northwest side of Prosperity Ave. Pleasant Valley, being known and designated as Lot No. 150, Pleasant Valley near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, according to a plat of subdivision prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in April 1946, as revised in June, 1946, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P, Page 93, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Prosperity Ave. the joint front corner of lots Nos. 150 and 151, 118.5 feet from the intersection of Prosperity and Patomac Aves. and running thence along the northwestern line of Prosperity Ave. N 40-26 E. 92.2 feet to corner of Lot No. 149; thence S. 89-52 W. 247.4 feet along the boundary lines of lots Nos. 149, 147 and 146 to the joint rear corners of Lots 146, 145 and 152; thence along the eastern boundary of Lot No. 152 S. 0-08 E. 70 feet to corner of Lot No. 151; thence along the line of Lot No. 151 N. 89-52 E. 187.5 feet to the point of beginning on Prosperity Ave. and being one of the lots conveyed to the said George C. Young by T. A. Ferguson by deed dated April 29, 1950, and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 408, Page 285."

The grantor agrees to pay all taxes against said property for the year 1956.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

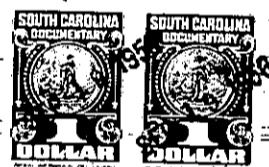
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and his Heirs and Assigns forever.
