"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the southeast side of Alaska Avenue (formerly Morningside Drive) in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 6 on plat of Parkview, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June, 1942, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, page 49, and having according to a recent survey by T. C. Adams, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast side of Alaska Avenue, the joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7, point of beginning being 250 feet from Nichol Town Road, and running thence with Alaska Avenue N. 53-43 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 5 and 6; and running thence with the joint line of said lots S. 36-17 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-43 W. 50 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots 6 and 7; and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 36-17 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner."
