ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being composed of two tracts and containing in the aggregate 100 acres more or less, and having the following description.

TRACT 1, containing 45 acres, beginning at a hickory near head waters of the North Saluda River and running down said river to the conditional line between W. C. Lindsay and J. C. Cannon and up the sink hold branch to its head; thence to a pine corner; thence to another pine on Rocky Ridge; thence to a chestnut oak on the side of Rocky Ridge; thence back to the beginning corner.
