

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said RUBY M. BEASON,
her heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the east side of West Lake Shore Drive in the Lake Lanier Subdivision and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of West Lake Shore Drive at the Southwest corner of lot formerly belonging to C. M. Littlefield, Jr. and running thence South 62 - 50 East 213.5 feet to an iron pin on the edge of the waters of Lake Lanier; thence South 2 - 20 West 47 feet to a stake on the edge of the waters of Lake Lanier; thence North 78 West 215 feet, more or less, to a stake on the East side of West Lake Shore Drive; thence North 12 East 100 feet to an iron pin, being the point of BEGINNING.
