

W	presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. J. Wilson and Anne Jackson lilson, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL our right, title and interest in and to that strip or parcel or land near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as a 20 foot alley on a plat of the property of W. H. Alford, made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, September 21, 1955, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "II", at Page 132, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the joint line of Lots 1 and 2 as shown on said plat at the rear corner of Lot 1 and running thence with the line of Lot 2, N. 47-51 E. 20 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-55 E. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-05 W. 20 feet to an iron pin at the corner of lot 1 on said plat; thence along the rear line of lot 1, N. 41-55 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner.

It is the intent of the Grantors to convey to the Grantees herein any interest or right which grantors have in and to the use of that 20 foot alley adjacent to and along the rear of lot 1, as shown on the plat of property of W. H. Alford, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "II", at Page 182, said 20 foot alley having been abandoned as an alley, said proposed alley never having been opened or used for that purpose.
