

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these quit-claim
quit-claim presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Alvin Eugene Smith and G. H. shop, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL our right, title and interest inand to that strip or parcel of land, near theCity of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as a 50 foot proposed street extending from Worley Road to Raines Avenue, on a plat of Property of W. H. Alford, made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, September 21, 1955, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "II", at Page 182, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Worley Road, at the point where the Northeast side of said Worley Road intersects with the Northwest side of said 50 foot proposed street, and running thence N. 48-05 E. 600 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Raines Avenue; thence along the Southwest side of Raines Avenue, S. 25-47 E. 52.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-05 W. 600 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Worley Road,; thence with the Northeast side of Worley Road, N. 25-47 W. 52.2 feet to the beginning corner.

It is the intent of the Grantors to convey to the Grantees herein any interest or right which grantors have in and to the use of that 50 foot proposed street as shown on the plat of property of W. H. Alford, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "II", at Page 182, said proposed 50 foot street having been abandoned as a street, said proposed street never having been opened or used for that purpose. The interest in the above property herein conveyed was acquired by the Grantors as owners of Lots 1 and 2 on the plat above mentioned.
